

Bring Home Some Milk

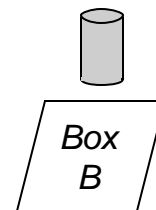
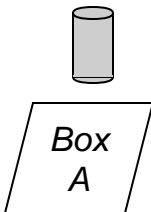
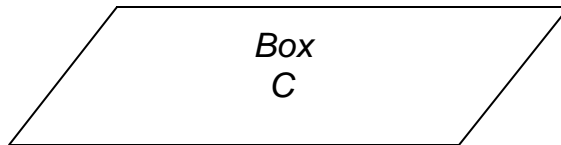
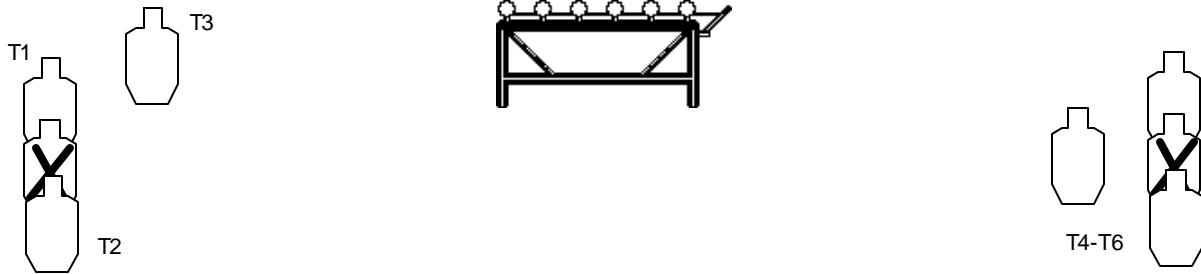
START POSITION: Standing in either Box A or Box B, gun holstered, with both hands holding milk jug.

STAGE PROCEDURE

Upon start signal, draw and engage either T1-T3 or T4-T6, whichever array is OPPOSITE the box you start in. Proceed to opposite box and engage the other array. Deposit the milk jug in the bucket in front of the OPPOSITE box that you start in. Proceed to Box C, and engage P1-P6 on the plate rack. If any part of the milk jug is touching the ground outside the bucket, or the milk jug is not placed in the proper bucket, one procedural penalty will be assessed.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 18 rounds, 70 points
TARGETS: 6 IPSC, 6 Plates
SCORED HITS: Best 2 per IPSC, steel down = 1A
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Procedural. -10
